Dear Students,

I am writing to follow up on the email you received today from Provost Singh regarding the transition of classroom-based courses to online modality, effective March 13, 2020 through the duration of the March term.

Your current March Term course has been identified as one in which the entire course cannot be converted an online format. As such this email outlines changes being made to your specific course for this month.

Please note the following for your current courses in the month of March:

- All lecture components of the course will move to an online format
 - Your faculty will be following up with instructions shortly.
- Practicum students working in the field may continue working in their placements as long as their sites remain open and allow you to continue your practicum at this time.
 - Changes to this plan may occur on a case-by-case basis and are at the discretion of your clinical or practicum site.
 - Please keep in contact with your practicum faculty with any questions, concerns or needs as they arise.
- All BIO courses with labs will be moved online for March as of tomorrow 03/13/2020. Your instructors will inform you of the course content for the remaining two weeks of this term.
- PHS 179A currently being taught at the Spectrum Campus will remain onsite. You will get further information from your instructor and Dr. Dawn Tamarkin, Chair of Mathematics and Natural Sciences.

For the time-being, no decisions have been made regarding the format or modality of any future courses, starting with the April term. We will be in contact regarding information about future courses.
